Gaming goes Hollywood

Origin Systems puts record \$3 million into creation of its new CD-ROM game — and breaks ground on the future of computing for the fun of it

As Star Wars hero Luke Skywalker, actor Mark Hamill battled the forces of evil on the big screen. Hamill is back fighting the good fight, but these days it's on a computer screen.

And if Origin Systems has its way, the star of its upcoming interactive computer game will do more than save the human race.

The company hopes *Wing Commander III*, scheduled to debut this fall, will set the standard for a new genre of computer games that combines Hollywood moviemaking and multimedia wizardry — available only on CD-ROM.

"No one has done this to a Hollywood scale yet," said Chris Roberts, executive producer and Origin vice president of new technology. "We want this to really shake the market up."

Industry watchers predict that Origin, which hired Hollywood screen writers, actors and cinematographers to make *Wing Commander III*, will deliver.

"They've emerged as a leader," said Russell Sipe, publisher of *Computer Gaming World*. "Hollywood has got movie making

down to a science, and Origin is putting that level of expertise into this project." Filming took place at Haven Hearst Studio in Los Angeles with a cast including Malcolm McDowell, who starred in *A Clockwork Orange* and the upcoming *Milk Money* with Melanie Griffith, John Rhys-Davies, who played Harrison Ford's sidekick Sallah in *Raiders of the Lost Ark*, and *Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade*, and Ginger Lynn Allen who appeared in *Young Guns II*.

The actors fought intergalactic wars and struggled to save humanity. The sets were sparsely furnished, large green studio backdrops were used for shooting during the five weeks of shooting.

MAKING love in a hot air balloon something like two thousand feet is no high on the list of ambitions of most of us. But somebody had that in mind when they rang Sue Tatum.

They wanted to join a kind of mile-high club, without the benefit of soft music and double glazing.

This sort of activity in a basket certainly gives a whole new meaning to Noel Edmonds' Crinkly Bottom.

But Sue took it all in her stride and advised the would-be high flier that while they might not mind, the other eight passengers might find it all a little off-putting.

Sue is a partner in Freetime Balloons, who are based in the Sudbury area.

Their huge blue and yellow balloon - registration number G-TATE - is seen most evenings and many early mornings taking off from Henny and soaring into the skies.

And it has become quite a pleasant occasion for hundreds of people who suddenly get the chance to put their trust in the whims of the winds ... and a good pilot!

The pilot is Sue's son, Philip Lowe, who now has over 450 hours of balloon flying experience. When he qualified five years ago at the age of 21 he was the youngest commercial pilot in the country.

To qualify, Philip had to undergo a thorough training recognised by the Civil Aviation Authority which included a four-hour examination at Watwick Airport.

The balloon - and its various attachments, including the basket - have to be serviced and replaced regularly.

And it's expensive - the balloon itself cost around £30,000.

And then there's the insurance ... passenger liability cover of £1 million!

It all makes the cost of taking a flight, around £100 per passenger, seem comparatively reasonable.

And 600 passengers last year and over 550 so far this year have been prepared to pay ... many of them having benefited from the gift voucher system that Freetime offer.

Val Jackson of Sudbury was one of them and she was extremely nervous as the balloon lifted off to carry her away on a birthday flight arranged by her husband David.

"I'm absolutely terrified," she said as the basket started to sway as it caught the wind. But she put on a cheerful wave for the benefit of her two offspring, Paul, aged eight and four-year-old Katie, as they looked on with a little awe and wonder at it all.

On the other side of the basket was Joyce Hedges, who was also on a birthday flight to celebrate her 70 years. Actually she's not 70 until January, but it's a trifle cold for all but the hardest of balloon enthusiasts at that time of year!

She was so carried away by it all that at the end she declared that next time she would have to think about taking a parachute jump...

Philip turns on the two huge burners that send hot air searing

into the heart of the balloon and things really start to lift off.

Within seconds we are gliding along, borne on the wind and approaching 500 feet. On this occasion we are heading across the edge of Sudbury in the direction of North Essex.

There's Ballingdon below and the whole area takes on a new perspective as you are above the crossroads yet level with the top of Ballingdon Hill.

Down to the right, Sudbury is suddenly a whole new landscape - a mere dot of mottled russet, grey slate and mellowed ochre, on a huge area of yellow-and-green patterned countryside.

The Stour meanders through it all like some silver-hued snake before disappearing in the distance under a valley of trees.

Further on, Pentlow Tower sticks out of the foliage like

some forbidding finger and Val's nervousness now completely dispelled, chatters about its history and the Reverend Bull who built it, and throws in the tale of the Ghost of Borley as well for good measure.

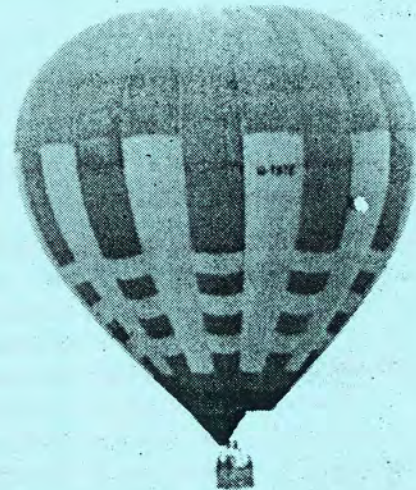
The balloon almost hovers as Philip allows it to drop for a closer look and it seems you can almost grasp the leaves of the trees just below.

The total silence is interrupted by the whoosh of the burners and the balloon soars again to reach a height of two thousand feet.

Now it seems the whole world is laid out below like some huge patchwork quilt.

The main road between Long Melford and Clare has been reduced to a thin sliver of black tarmac and the cars have become tiny Dinky toys.

Sue's husband and business

partner Graham, who is in the pilot's compartment with Philip, studies a map and they confer as the balloon glides along a flightpath in the direction of Highpoint Prison - it once landed there and permission had to be sought before the passengers could be let out - and there's Cavendish down to the right and Clare to the left.

We are high over Poslingford now and descending. The shadow of the balloon and the sound of the burners sends a small posse of cows scurrying and Graham points towards a stubble field that has a slope rising gently away from us.

Philip attracts the attention of the passengers and repeats the landing brief.

"Turn your back away from the direction we are travelling in, grab the rope handles and bend your knees slightly" he says.

"And," he adds, "when we come to a stop, don't get out otherwise the balloon will lift off again."

There is some reassurance as the point of most concern to us all - the actual landing - rapidly approaches... the small convoy of families and friends' cars, and the Freetime back-up crew, are already almost at the landing site.

The balloon now seems to be going much faster - somebody

informs us that it is the speed of a parachutist landing - the basket contacts the ground and flips on its side and we are whisked across the ground on our backs.

Stubble dust flies everywhere but the fear is gone and it's all quite exhilarating. Suddenly the basket comes to a halt. You lie there regaining your equilibrium and before you know it, there's somebody to give you a helping hand to your feet.

The crew depart to get permission from the landowner to take the Land-Rover onto the field to recover the balloon.

"We always seek permission first and the farmers have always been good, some of them have become friends," says Sue, who has caught up with us and appears with steaming cups of coffee for all.

There are tales to tell while the crew start to roll the balloon up and stow it in a large canvas pouch and the basket and burners are lifted onto a trailer.

Philip announces that it has been a good flight and Sue emerges with a certificate each, to certify that each passenger took off from Henny near Sudbury and landed at Hundon... a distance of some twelve-and-a-half miles that took almost an hour!

Truly a flight of fantasy.

The computer disks are compressed and archived using DiskDoubler Pro. I have included that application along with its accessories. To assemble files first launch DD Pro and select "Graphic DD 1" via the hierarchical menus. With this selected go up to the DD Menu at the top of the screen and select "Join." This will join the files after which the "DD" file can be expanded normally. Please call if this doesn't seem to work.

Alpine - We love it!

If you've never flown Alpine, you've missed a great experience. Alpine is north of Big Bend in a volcanic "bowl". The surrounding mountains provide protection from morning winds and actually trap cool morning air creating very calm AM flying conditions.

Chris and Martin Theophilus acted as crew and tour guide for us (Martin grew up in Alpine and attended Sul Ross State University in Alpine). On Friday night after the registration reception Martin gave us a tour of the town and then drove us into the mountains south of town to see Cathedral Peak and watch the sunset.

Being on the west side of the time zone, sunrise is a little later than here in Austin, so we were able to sleep in later before heading for the launch area. When we arrived at the field on Saturday morning we picked up additional crew and imagine our surprise to find that one of our crew was sightless. As it turned out, Barbara is very independent, and has been trained to operate various industrial tools, including an industrial sewing machine. Her friends convinced me that she could operate the fan, so I gave her a quick overview and she ran the fan for us. She wanted to drive the crew truck.....

Martin rode with me to video the event. This was his first balloon flight over his hometown. The launch was uneventful in the calm morning air, and we climbed almost straight up before heading northeast toward the airport where we landed on the main runway, deflated and packed up. I had a moment of concern when I heard an airplane and looked up to see a plane on approach preparing to land where we were packing up! The pilot finally saw us, aborted the approach and flew back around into the approach pattern. I wasn't sure what he had in mind as he began his second approach, but then he set the plane down on the parallel taxi way.

In the afternoon, Martin acted as tour guide again and we headed north to Fort Davis and stopped for lunch at Indian Lodge. Great food at an excellent price! After more sightseeing we headed back (I napped) to get ready for the evening glow. The winds had come up and the glow was canceled.

Sunday was much the same as the previous day. Two of our crew, Bobbie and Frank, invited us to launch from their ranchette. They have a large pasture that was a perfect launch area. I took Barbara up with me for her first balloon flight. I was surprised to find that she was very sensitive to the movement of the balloon and was able to tell when we were ascending, descending and even some changes of direction. We flew for about 30 minutes, and then landed to trade passengers. Another uneventful launch and a great flight. We landed on the Frank Dougherty Ranch. Frank D came

out to greet us and informed us that if we were "competing in a cross Atlantic flight, we were headed in the wrong direction". Since it was warming up and we had been flying for about an hour and a half we deflated and headed back. We had a surprise waiting when we returned. Frank (crew, not Frank D) and Bobbie's neighbor had called the organizers to complain about my launching too close to her ranch and horse barns. We had not flown over the ranch, and had launched about 200 yards away, but the owner was concerned the noise would scare her horses.

Sunday evening was the backup date for the glow, but once again the wind was too strong. Some of the pilots did a burner glow. We headed for the Marfa lights viewing area.

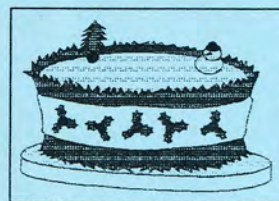
Monday turned out to be the calmest of the three days. We flew for about two hours and about 5 miles. My passenger was Micki Clouse. Micki is a member of the city council and candidate for mayor. She is a neat lady and well known in Alpine - which would turn out to be very fortunate for us. After being becalmed for more than thirty minutes (and 2 miles from the road) we set the balloon down on Ms Rebecca Smith's ranch. Ms Smith was not pleased, but finally granted access to the crew to come get me. On our way out, I stopped to talk with Ms Smith. Micki said she would help since she knows Ms Smith. As we drove up, Ms Smith looked more than a little irritated. I introduced myself and as I began to thank her, Micki stepped up and said "Hi, Becky!" Ms Smith's face changed completely. It turned out they are very good friends! We talked for a bit, and then headed back to town after promising to take Becky for a ride when we return next year.



Before heading home, we made one more stop at the ranch where the complaint had come from the previous day. We met Mrs Mayes, former (recent!) Miss Texas and wife of Harley Mayes, Rodeo Champion. The Mayes raise horses and had 17 champion stock in pens and corrals next to the house. She was very pleasant, and after talking for a few minutes, she invited us to see the horses. When we finally left about 45 minutes later, we had been introduced to every animal by name, we had patted each one, and knew which was being bred to which, and when the foals are due. It was fun and when we left Mrs Mayes, we felt we had created a friend for ballooning in Alpine.

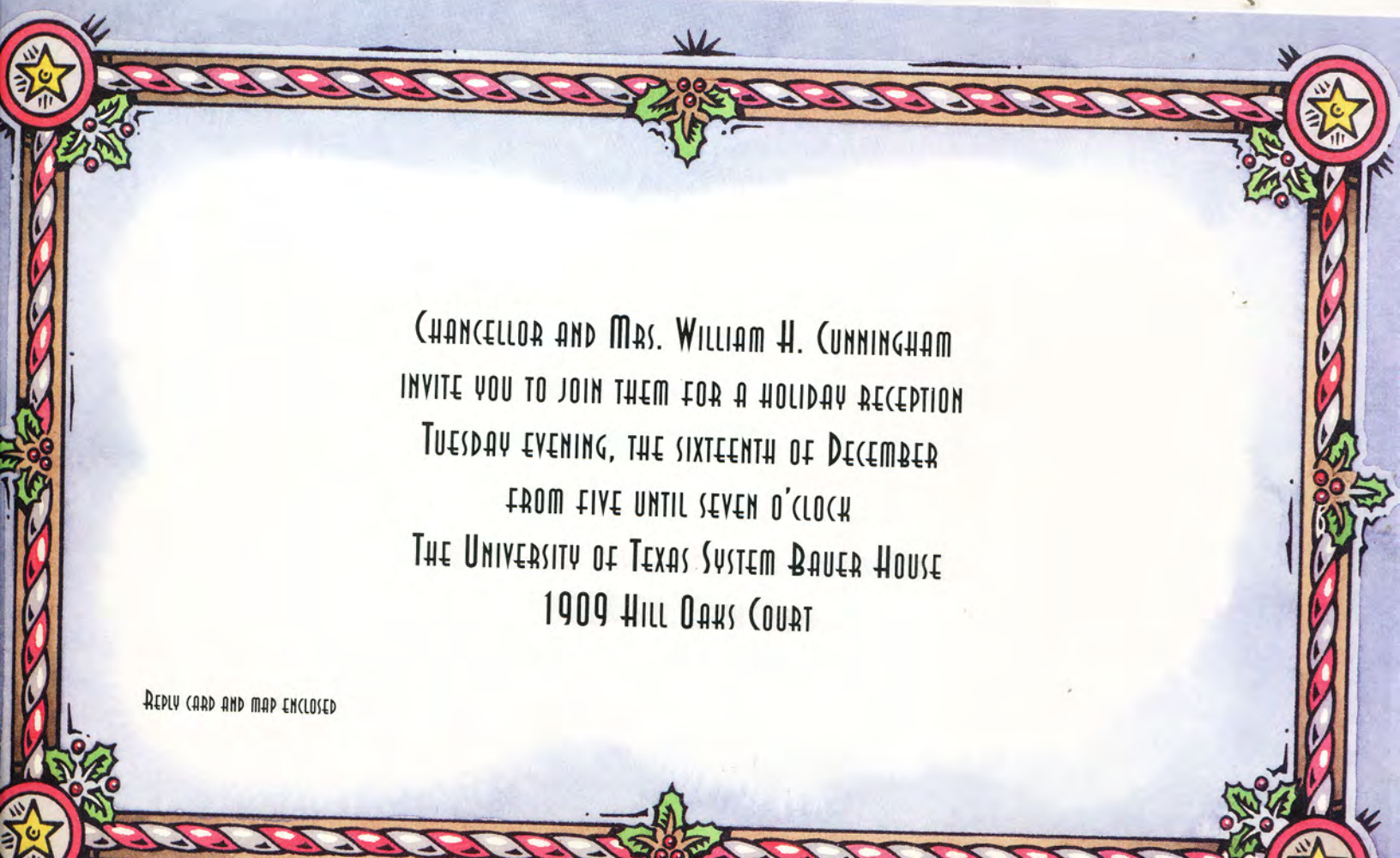

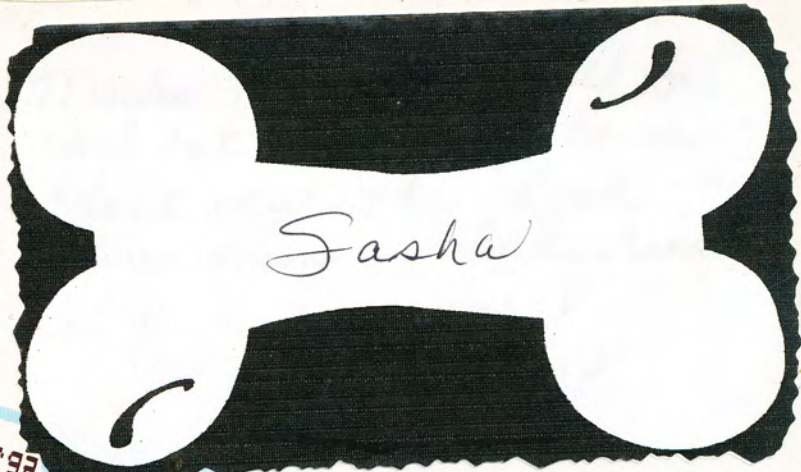
