
THE OBSERVATION DECK, closed since 1977, was reopened to the public starting August 16, 1980.

In Austin, a city whose musical roots lie in progressive country and rhythm and blues, pop vocalists are hard to find. *Female* pop vocalists are even rarer. Deborah Giles intends to change all that. The blonde, Dallas-born beauty made Austin her home eight years ago—and she's been turning heads ever since.

Best known as lead vocalist for the pop/rock band "Private Lives," Giles sent Austin FM radio reeling with the first single she released. "Private Lives' " single, "When the World Comes Crashing Through," had radio DJ's, TV stations and music listeners buzzing. The single made so many waves that it was ultimately voted "Best Texas 45 rpm" in the 1983 Austin Chronicle Music Poll and KVUE-TV aired a special 30-minute program entitled, "Private Lives: How To Make A Hit Single." Radio fans showed their appreciation of the song when it was listed #68 in the Top 98 Songs for 1983 by the #1 CHR station, KHFI-FM. Giles was a "first time out sensation" according to the press. Austin wasn't used to local pop stars, so Giles' professional work had audiences cheering. With the release of "Private Lives'" first album, Billboard praised the songs, the album's production and Giles' vocals, saving "the band is fronted by a powerful and confident-sounding singer named Deborah Giles." Confident is right! Deborah Giles' vocal style lends an air of authenticity and sincerity. She can deliver a soulful, pop ballad or lightheartedly cruise through an uptempo rock celebration. Through it all. Giles projects an aura of mystery to her songs. Her talent includes all the ingredients necessary for pop/rock stardom.

Giles' accessible song style attracts interest from a variety of celebrity musicians when she's in the studio. Chris Layton, drummer for "Stevie Ray Vaughan and Double Trouble," and Huw Gower, guitarist with Graham Parker and a former member of "The Records," have each lent their production expertise to Giles' latest studio projects. Saxophone wizard, Joe Sublett of "The Delbert McClinton Band," added his touch to the newest cut, entitled "Losin' My Life." Gower says of Deborah Giles, "She most definitely makes you want to hear more of her. She's quite a performer, both in the studio and on the stage. A powerful performer because she mixes that authority necessary to keep an audience with her keen sense of humor. She's quite a show!" When Giles isn't performing or recording, she works as office manager for Texas Monthly, a National Magazine-award winning publication. She is also a model for magazine advertisements and an actress in television commercials.





















